Bethesda, Md. —Strathmore presents The Pink Floyd Experience: six brilliant musicians, a dazzling light show and full quadraphonic sound all dedicated to recreating an authentic Pink Floyd rock show. Pink Floyd's impact on modern music is immeasurable. The band has multiple entries in the top 30 best selling albums of all time including *The Dark Side of the Moon*, the longest consecutively charted album in history. Pink Floyd no longer performs and this is the closest anyone can get to the real thing. The Pink Floyd Experience features music from the legendary band's entire 40-year catalog including hits from *The Dark Side of the Moon*, *Wish You Were Here* and *The Wall*. Performing these classics are six musicians, Tom Quinn, lead guitar, Gus Beaudoin, bass guitar, Graham Heath, lead vocalist, Jesse Mollow, saxophone, John Cox, keyboards and John Staten, drums. They have played together since 1995, garnering multiple San Diego Music Awards for their faithful recreation of the notoriously conceptual and atmospheric concerts attributed to Pink Floyd since 1964. The Pink Floyd Experience covers deep tracks for the ultimate Pink Floyd fan as well as the popular radio hits that everyone will recognize—an unforgettable experience for the casual and diehard fan alike.

Rather than recreate the enormous stadium shows that made Pink Floyd famous in the late 1970s through the 1990s, The Pink Floyd Experience strives to combine the intimacy of Pink Floyd's early concerts with the spectacle of the later ones. The music is presented alongside a light show coordinated in tandem with the songs. The result is a combination of sights, sounds and sensations that attack all the senses and create a truly unique event for rock music fans.
